Terms and Conditions of Refunds

1. Cooling Off Period

All memberships have a seven day cooling off period. The contract of membership can be voided within seven days of joining without further obligation and a full refund obtained.

2. Refunds

All refunds are calculated from the date of application. After the cooling off period, as outlined above, reimbursement of the unused portion of your membership may be credited to other services in the facility, or shall be refunded via EFT payment into the bank account.

Refunds may be provided in full where:

- A medical condition precludes further participation and a medical certificate is provided;
 or
- A member relocates residence more than 20km from this facility and provides supporting
- · documentation; or
- A Y NSW Program, for which a customer has been enrolled, has been cancelled.

3. Processing Period

Refunds will be processed as soon as possible. Please allow approximately two weeks for payment.

4. Non-standard Refunds

Refund requests beyond the standard applications should be made in writing to the Manager.

5. Merchandise
